



axe10app (download) Data Protection Policy

Introduction

This policy details the legally compliant use of “axe10app”, which is a software application, that is developed, owned and distributed by Axeten Ltd.

axe10app allows for effective gathering of material with eDisclosure reporting, and eForensic logging and hashing of all material files.

Scope of axe10app Compliance

When downloaded and installed by the Customer, axe10app has no personal data.

The application itself, does not store any personal data.

Therefore, axe10app is not subject to any data protection legislation.

Axeten has no requirement to store the personal data of a Customer user.

Axeten and the Customer Admin user shall agree login credentials for login purposes. Axeten takes all reasonable steps to manage the collection and safe storage of such information in accordance with data protection legislation (Please see axe10app Security Policy and Protocol).

The login credentials include a user-name and a password for the Customer user (Please see axe10app Security Policy and Protocol).

Login credentials are necessary for the authentication process, so that the Customer user is validated as a legitimate user with rights to deploy axe10app.

The login credentials are stored in an encrypted format on a secure server, and are communicated to the Axeten server using the TLS 1.2 cryptographic protocol.

Customer Compliance

Where the Customer deploys axe10app for research purposes, the nature of the activity is to collect personal information on Third Party people that are subject of research.

All Third Party personal data gathered by the Customer is saved to the local hard drive of the Customer, so that no data acquired by the Customer is transferred to any server managed or owned by Axeten.

Therefore, Axeten requires all Customers to have in place appropriate data protection protocols, and to publish their compliance documentation, so that where a Customer acquires and deploys axe10app, it does so in a manner that is compliant with legislation, guidelines and practices.

Relevant Legislation

- EU Regulation 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation) of the European Parliament and of the Council, issued on 27 April 2016. This concerns the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data , and;
- Data Protection Act 2018 and any sub-legislation contained therein, where;
- part 3 of the Act transposes the EU Data Protection Directive 2016/680 (Law Enforcement Directive) into domestic UK law. The Directive complements the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and sets out the requirements for the processing of personal data for criminal 'law enforcement purposes'.
